The Canadian National Para Soccer Team has come a long way since its inception in 2005. Back then, the team was ranked 38th in the world; today, the team is ranked 12th. Over the past four years, the team has travelled across Canada and internationally to countries such as Brazil, Argentina, Portugal, Holland, England, and the USA to participate in training camps, tournaments, and the CPISRA 7-A-Side World Championships. Our player pool has grown from 15 players to now over 70 players from 8 to 42 years of age.

- A Canadian citizen
and
- Mild Cerebral Palsy
and/or
- An acquired brain injury
and/or
- A recovering stroke victim
