



2011 PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS



6.5.2 Three (3) points shall be awarded for a win and one (1) point for a tie (including taking of kicks from the penalty mark). Standings shall be determined by points won at the completion of the round robin, with tie-breaking as outlined in rule 6.5.3.

6.5.3 The following criteria shall be used, in order, to determine the final standings:

- (a) Most points in all group matches
- (b) Great number of points in all matches between the teams concerned
- (c) Great goal difference in matches between the teams concerned (if more than two teams finish equal on points)
- (d) Greater number of goals scored in matches among the teams concerned (if more than two teams finish equal on points)
- (e) Greater goal difference in all group matches
- (f) Greater number of goals scored in all group matches
- (g) Penalty kicks

Two Clubs tied: as per FIFA Laws of the Game, at a time and place decided by the MSA Provincial Championship Competitions Committee

Three Clubs tied: each Club is designated A, B or C. Three penalty shoot-outs shall be played (A vs B, A vs C, B vs C) consisting of five kicks from the penalty mark at a time and place determined by the MSA Provincial Championship Competitions Committee. The standings after these three shoot-outs shall be ranked according to the criteria (a) – (d).

Players under suspension are not eligible to participate; however this does not constitute the serving of any disciplinary suspension already awarded.
