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HOSTING A DISTRICT YOUTH REFEREE CLINIC

OBLIGATIONS OF THE HOST:

- a) Apply for the clinic by fully completing the MSA application form and returning it.
- b) **Clinic fees:**
The host is responsible for paying the course fee to the MSA when invoiced.
- c) **Law books:**
FIFA Law books will be sent to the participants prior to the clinic. The host is required to inform the MSA of the number of participants **a minimum of two weeks prior to the clinic** in order to ship the Law books to the Host Organizing Group for distribution amongst the clinic participants. A shipping address must be provided to the MSA.
- d) **Facility:**
A classroom environment is required (chair/desk) to comfortably accommodate the number of participants. Washroom facility should also be available.
For the practical sessions a gymnasium is required if outdoor fields are not ready. A soccer field lined with goals is preferred for the practical sessions.
- e) **Equipment:**
The following equipment **MUST** be made available:
1. LCD Projector 2. Screen 3. Soccer balls.
If you do not have access to this equipment, please inform the MSA on the application form.
- f) **Module 1 & 2: Classroom Sessions - 3 hours each in duration.**
Module 3 & 4: Field or Gymnasium Sessions – 3 hours each in duration.
- g) **Administrative Session:**
The host is required to provide an information session to discuss the administrative duties of the association.
